RUSSELL TOWNSHIP IS A GLOW WITH NEW STREET LIGHTS

Russell Township benefits from new, LED street lights.

Embrun, Ontario - Wednesday, August 28, 2016, Mayor Pierre Leroux, members of council, staff and the Realterm Energy team celebrate the completion of the retrofit of streetlights throughout the entire Township of Russell. The LED streetlight retrofit means a 66% savings in energy and 80% savings in maintenance.

The total cost of the project (approximately \$489,500) will pay for itself in approximately 3 years. The project began earlier this summer and was completed on-time in August.

“The short term cost of the LED streetlight project allows the municipality to be more energy efficient and also allows significant cost savings long term. This is a win-win for the Township of Russell.” adds Mayor Pierre Leroux.

Conveniently located 25 minutes south-east of Ottawa, Russell Township serves a vibrant, caring, bilingual and growing population of approximately 16,000 individuals that includes (primarily) young families, educated professionals, spirited entrepreneurs and talented tradespeople in an expansive rural setting.
